- Closed shoes
- A pair of socks
- Hat (In case the UV levels are 3 or over)
- Blue Centre Hat for Excursions. If you have not already purchased a blue hat for your child, we will provide one on the excursion day and apply the \$10 fee to your account.
- A water bottle or 2 if we are going on an excursion
- Jumper or jacket (something warm to wear if it gets cold)
- A spare change of clothes in case of any accidents
- Healthy Lunch and lots of it. (No Nuts or bi-products of nuts)
- Healthy snacks
- Hat (yes again ... it's important)
- If your child brings their own sunscreen, a reminder to reapply every two hours

To ensure we staff and cater accordingly, Abbotsford Community Centre requires 2 weeks' notice, in writing for a booking **<u>cancellation</u>**. If this notice is not given, the day will be marked as an absence.

Important Daily Information:

Monday 8th July:

The Indigenous Clay Incursion runs from 10-12.00pm. Bookings for this incursion will be capped at 60.

Tuesday 9th July:

The Dinosaur Discovery Incursion runs from 10-12.00pm. Bookings for this incursion will be capped at 70.

<u>Wednesday 10th July:</u>

Departure: 11.30am. Return 2.30pm. We are walking to Halliday Park for the excursion today. <u>Bookings for this</u> excursion will be capped at 60.

Friday 12th July:

Today is Wheels Day and we encourage children to bring their bikes or scooters and helmets with them to the Centre. We understand that this can be tough for families to fit multiple bikes in cars or coordinate riding to the Centre in the morning so feel free to bring your bikes/scooters in the day before and these can be kept locked away in the Centre overnight.

Tuesday 16th July:

Thursday 18th July:

For our Teddy Bear Picnic today, we are asking all children to bring in their favourite teddy's. These can be stored safely in the office while they are not being used.

Friday 19th July:

Departure: 9.00am. Return 12.30pm. Bookings for this excursion will be capped at 60.

Monday 22nd July:

Departure: 9.45am. Return 1.30pm. Bookings for this excursion will be capped at 80.

- Certain excursion and incursion days are capped due to provider limits and bus capacity limits.
- A waitlist will be created for any days where demand is higher than capacity. Waitlist priority will be in line with the Federal Government's Priority of Access Guidelines. Those on the waitlist will be notified 24 hours prior if they have been able to secure a placement.
- Excursion costs will be charged for each child booked. If eligible, Childcare Subsidy (CCS) is available and will include the sum of the base fee and the excursion cost.
- Direct Debit details can be entered in the Xplor Home App. Children will not be able to attend vacation care unless direct debit has been set up.
- All payments will be deducted from accounts fortnightly on a Wednesday.
- Lunch, afternoon tea, and fruit will be provided every day we are at the Centre. Children will still need to bring their own recess and drinks.
- Food <u>will not</u> be provided by the Centre on days we are out on excursions and must be provided by the family.
- Please continue to provide extra food as the children burn off heaps of energy on vacation care days and get really hungry.
- Numbers may be limited for some excursions, so make sure you get in quick!
